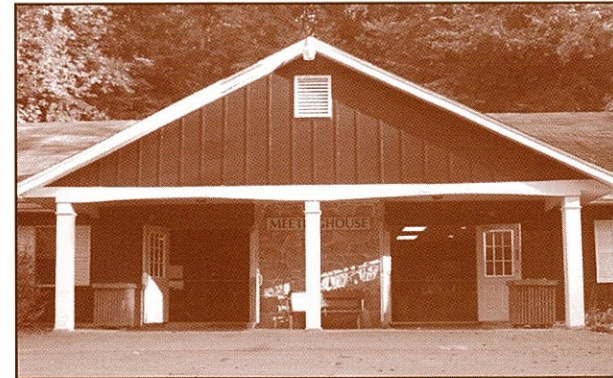

Because this WKC is a time of rest and spiritual refreshment, we encourage those persons with children to provide for childcare at home. Childcare will not be offered at the conference.



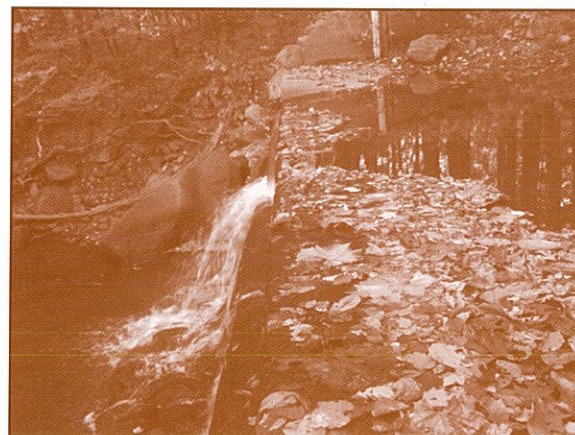
